## Individual Computer Requirements

Display resolution (required)	1024 x 768
RAM	128 MB, minimum (higher preferred)
Processor	Pentium II-300 MHz, minimum (higher preferred)
Microsoft Access (required) Version: 2000, 2002, 2003, or 2007	Purchased separately or as part of Microsoft Office Professional. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hard drive space required: 170 MB</li> <li>• Latest service pack installed. <a href="http://support.microsoft.com/sp">http://support.microsoft.com/sp</a></li> </ul>
Lodgepole storage space (required)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20 MB for initial installation.</li> <li>• 100 MB, additional hard drive space for database expansion. Technically 2 GB for the storage of the data, but it will be rare that any property will use/ need this much space</li> </ul>
Lodgepole storage space (optional)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Approximately 1-3 GB for storage of images and documents, depending on property's needs.</li> <li>• Can be located on computer, external hard drive, or network.</li> </ul>
Adobe Reader (required). Free.	Needed to view Lodgepole® Property System license and manual.
Microsoft Excel and Word (optional)	For report export capabilities. Note: Access has very limited export formatting capabilities.
Regular backup storage (required)	Stand-alone computer: USB flash drive, server, or CD-RW drive

## Network Requirements

Configuration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lodgepole files are copied to a folder on the network.</li> <li>• Shortcuts are created (with a command line) on each individual's desktop that point to the files on the network drive.</li> <li>• Each computer must have the individual computer requirements met (listed above)</li> </ul>
Drive Configuration	Two choices: a separate drive for Lodgepole or simply create a new folder on an existing drive.
Folder security	You can accommodate different types of users: 1) users that input and revise data need FULL permissions on both the Lodgepole folder and any parent folder and 2) users who view the data or run reports need read only permissions.
Remote control (not remote access)	Remote control and a FAST connection. Contact us for further details.
Regular backup storage and system	Network: regular backup system
